Why study Health?

Over two years, you will develop knowledge and understanding of the health and science sector, including learning about how to support health and wellbeing, core science concepts, human anatomy, and much more through the core component and two occupational specialisms, 'Supporting the Adult Nursing Team' and 'Supporting the Care of Children and Young People'. This course offers a mixture of classroom learning and 'on-the-job' experience during an industry placement.

Overview of course content

T Level

Core Content worth 50% of the qualification

Throughout the course, you will develop a general understanding of health and science:

- working within the health and science sector
- health, safety and environmental regulations
- managing information and data
- principles of good scientific and clinical practice
- core science concepts including the structure of cells, tissues and large molecules, genetics, microbiology and immunology

You will also learn about topics specific to health, including:

- understanding the healthcare sector
- providing person-centred care
- supporting health and wellbeing
- further knowledge of both human anatomy and physiology and of diseases and disorders
- infection prevention and control.

Course Specialisms worth 50% of the qualification

In addition to the core content, you will also complete two specialisms:

Supporting the Adult Nursing Team

- Assist the adult nursing team with clinical tasks
- Support individuals to meet activities of daily living
- Assist with skin integrity assessments and with the care and treatment of skin conditions

Supporting the Care of Children and Young People

- Assist with clinical tasks and treatment for children and young people
- Provide care and support to children and young people before, during and after clinical or therapeutic procedures
- Support parents, families and carers to meet the needs of children and young people
