

Why study the Foundation Programme?

The T Level Foundation Programme is a one-year course designed to give students access into a T Level course. This is ideal for those who need to retake their GCSEs (English and/or Maths), would benefit from the additional study time and preparation before they start a T Level or to develop confidence before applying for further study, apprenticeships or employment.

Overview of course content

T Level Foundation Programme

Core Content

This course is split into different areas:

- A practical coursework-based course that delivers the core National Technical Outcome (NTO)
- Concentration in a chosen technical specialism (Health, Education & Early Years, Business, Construction and Media)
- Two employer-based projects
- A Project Qualification (EPQ or HPQ)
- The World of Work: employability skills, preparation for work assignments and a work experience

Work Placement

Work experience placement following employability skills workshops and preparation for work assignments, delivered by qualified careers specialists and our in-house Industry Placement Officer. We will try to place students in a role relevant to their aspirations. This may not always be possible, due to age or location. Work experience is a very important part of the course and will help students gain confidence and knowledge of an industry they are looking at working in.

Careers/Future Opportunities

This course provides an ideal stepping stone to a T Level or alternative vocational qualifications. The subject content is deliberately broad so that it opens opportunities rather than narrowing them. This course provides an excellent foundation for apprenticeships and work-based pathways.
